The ASEAN region as a whole represents the EU's 3rd largest trading partner outside Europe (after the US and China) with more than €235 billion of trade in goods and services in 2012.



The EU is ASEAN's 3rd largest trading partner after China and Japan, accounting for around 13% of ASEAN trade. The EU is by far the largest investor in the ten ASEAN countries: Brunei, Cambodia. Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

EU companies have invested an average €14.8 billion annually in the region (2006-2013).

ASEAN as a region ranks 5th in EU Seventh Framework Programme (FP7) participation after Russia, US, China and India. More than 200 participants received about €28 million funding from FP7.

The total value of these projects amount to €517 million. 204 researchers from ASEAN countries conducted research in Europe as Marie Curie fellows.
