She will present empirical evidence on the need of best management practices to enhance the positive effects of digital tools and to counterbalance their negative effects.

Are routine tasks getting old? Job tasks and demographics in Europe (Piotr Lewandowski, IBS)

The twin forces of technological progress and globalization change the nature of work, and drive the shift away from routine work and towards non-routine work. However, they affect younger and older workers differently, contributing to between- and within-generation inequality in a surprising way.
