Hungary



- The aim of our project is to **provide an opportunity** for **disadvantaged families** who lives in social housing units and struggle with **rent arrears** to do something for themselves and for their surroundings.
- We carry out **renovations** involving tenants of **social housing units**. The owner local municipality reduces the participants' rent arrear by the increase in value of the renovated houses. The project also hosts **volunteers** from all over the country.

Reconstruction camps realized

- **April 2010:** two houses with 4 flats each
- **August 2010:** one house with 4 flats – Nagykanizsa, Southwest Hungary
- **August 2011** IDA programme – Völgység, Southwest Hungary
- **May 2012:**
one house with 9 flats, roof insulation for 3 other houses with 9 and 6 flats - Nagykanizsa
