- Review of the measurement framework for innovation (within the Oslo Manual)
- Cognitive testing techniques
- The role of design as a driver of innovation
- Public sector innovation survey
- Review of the R&D tax incentives
- Update of the OECD database on Careers of Doctorate Holders

### Other changes and directions of work

- Human resources for science and technology and mobility indicators
- Indicators of open access to science and impact
- Mixed Modes of Innovation: An Empiric Approach to Capturing Firms' Innovation Behaviour
- Creation of integrated platform of data and other information

#### Key directions of actions for the nearest years in statistics of innovation

- develop innovation indicators that can be linked to aggregate measures of economic performance;
- invest in a high quality and comprehensive statistical infrastructure to analyse innovation at the firm level;
- promote measures of innovation in the public sector and for public policy evaluation;
- find new and interdisciplinary approaches to capture knowledge creation and flows; and
- promote the measurement of innovation for social goals and of social impacts of innovation.

## What this means for other countries?

- The need to follow the changes closely
- The need to change their statistical standards
- The need to participate in joint activities (along with Russia, China and some other states)
- Create mechanisms for co-operation between different countries at regional level to defend their positions internationally
