SOUTH EAST EUROPE

South East Europe (SEE) is a key region for many ZSI activities. In the last 15 years, ZSI particularly developed a high profile in the analysis of policies and policy-making related to education, science, technological development and innovation in the SEE region (including Turkey). On behalf of the former Austrian Federal Ministry of Science and Research, ZSI hosted for many years the Austrian Science and Research Liaison Offices in Ljubljana and Sofia, responsible for supporting the bilateral and regional S&T cooperation between Austria and the partner countries, and coordinated several EU- and nationally funded high-profile projects in the area of research and innovation. ZSI can rely on a superb network consisting of national and regional policy makers, agencies and universities, business support structures (such as business incubators and science technology parks) as well as of individual researchers from different sectors in the whole region. ZSI employees speak several South East European languages and communicate easily with different stakeholders.
